Cambodia-

Since the beginning of our school in Cambodia more than 8 years ago. [10th Jan 2000] we have provided education to more than 25,000 students in total. Full Time boarding and part time. The present number of students is 360 for full time boarding students and around 250 for part time students in



Phnom Penh. For our centers in the 2 provinces, we have about 40 boarding students and more than 250 part time students. So many former students are today earning a living by providing education to the rural people in so many provinces of Cambodia.

International Program-

Our international program which started almost 2 years ago has moved from level 1 (Formula, theory) to Level 2 (Practice) and now to Level 3 (Leadership). All the students have developed both their soft and hard skills very well & now are taking up leadership roles.

East Timor-

Our East Timor school opened in Nov 2006 and ever since has been improving from leaps to bounds. 1 1/2 years ago, when we first opened the school with 24 students, the country was in uncertainty. In spite of all this, the enrollment rose to 60 & by October 07, after completing the new boys dorm, it rose to 140. In February '08, we completed the new girls dorm and opened our doors to another 130 boarding students and now we have a total of 269 full time boarding students. We also



have around 150 morning part-time students who study for 3 hours and around 150 evening part time students who study for 1 hour.

As the students are still new, they are concentrating on English, Discipline & Love & Unity. Our students come from all the 13 districts of East Timor.
